Student Expectation Agreement



1. Be....

- a. Yourself
- b. Present. Participate in all activities with an open mind and an open heart.
- c. Attentive. Listen carefully. Take every opportunity to learn. Participants and leaders can learn from each other.
- d. Cooperative. A caring and supportive attitude to each individual is expected.
- e. Respectful. Refrain from talking when others are speaking especially during group activities, presentations and small group.
- f. Mindful of the way you speak. Profanity, abusive language or the like will not be tolerated.
- g. Mindful of the way you dress. Inappropiate dress will not be tolerated.
- h. Honest. Share your concerns with appropriate adult and young adult leaders so that we can assist in bringing resolution to the matter.
- 2. Parents/Guardians and students have reviewed and agree to abide by the cell phone policy outlined by VMY SEMO.
- 3. Behavior that is deemed to be harrasing, hazing, or abusive will result in immediate dismissal from the event.
- 4. We are guests of the school, families, and organizations we are serving. It is expected that you treat all locations with dignity and respect.
 - a. Please assist the adult leaders by picking up after yourself. Everyone's help is needed in maintaining a clean and safe environment.
- 5. For safety, neither you or any unsupervised group, may leave a group activity or worksite or school location at any time without permission.
- 6. Girls are NOT ALLOWED in the boys' sleeping area at any time.
- 7. Boys are NOT ALLOWED in the girls' sleeping area at any time.
- 8. Students are NOT ALLOWED in adult sleeping areas except in emergency situations.



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- 9. Adults are NOT ALLOWED in student sleeping areas except in emergency situations or violation student expectations.
- 10. While we understand some students may be dating, it is important to know that hand holding, cuddling, kissing, and other public displays of affection are not allowed.
- 11. Lights outs mean light out. For your safety and the safety of others when lights out is announced you will promptly report to your sleeping quarters and go to sleep. Being disruptive in the sleeping quarters will not be tolerated.
- 12. Leaving your sleeping quarters after lights out, unless to go to the bathroom or in the event of an emergency, is prohibited.
- 13. The use of drugs, firearms, fireworks, tobacco, vaping products, pocket knives, or alcohol at any time.
 - a. All prescription medication, should either be listed on your registration form or brought to the attention of the Executive Director and/or Director of Operations before departing for the mission trip.
- 14. Parents will be notified of any student expectation violations.
- 15. Should a violation result in the dismissal of the student from the event parents will be responsible for picking up their student from the program location or arranging for private transportation home.
