

Operation Overhaul Student Expectations



Parents will be notified of a violation of the following expectations. Violation may result in appropriate punishment or in dismissal from the event depending on the severity of the instance.

- Students must be present during all activities
- For safety, neither you or any unsupervised group, may leave a group activity or worksite or school location at any time without permission.
- Students must act/speak in a respectful manner to young adults/adults and other students, this includes no profanity.
- Behavior that is deemed to be harassing, hazing, or abusive is prohibited
- Sharing of inappropriate material via social media platforms such as Snapchat, Instagram, Facebook, TikTok and the like is prohibited even during allotted cell phone time.
- Per the cell phone policy, cell phones are not permitted in Mass, on the worksite, Adoration, Reconciliation, group activities, small group, or any other time as deemed necessary by the leadership team. Violation of this policy will result in the device being confiscated for the remainder of the week and parents will be notified
- We are guests of the school and families we are serving. It is expected that you treat all locations with dignity and respect. This includes picking up after yourself during meal time and in the bathrooms/showers
- While we understand some students may be dating, but it is important to know that hand holding, cuddling, kissing, and other public displays of affection are not allowed.
- Lights out, unless to go to the bathroom or in the event of an emergency, is prohibited.
- Modest clothing is required. T-shirts and longer shorts/pants are the only acceptable form of clothing. Unacceptable clothing includes but is not limited to: tank tops, cut-offs, crop tops, leggings, shorts that are too short, bikinis, etc.
- Lights out means light out. For your safety and the safety of others when lights out is announced you will promptly report to your sleeping quarters and go to sleep. Leaving your sleeping quarters after
- Girls are NOT ALLOWED in the boys' sleeping area at any time and Boys are NOT ALLOWED in the girls' sleeping area at any time.
- Students are NOT ALLOWED in adult sleeping areas except in emergency situations and adults are NOT ALLOWED in student sleeping areas except in emergency situations or violation of lights out expectation.
- The use of drugs, firearms, fireworks, tobacco, vaping products, pocket knives, or alcohol at any time is prohibited. All prescription medication, should either be listed on your registration form or brought to the attention of the event nurses before departing for the mission trip.
